

Format Service Identifiers

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Setting Name: Format Service Identifiers.

This setting changes the format of a service identifier. It replaces a prefix with a zero prefix where there is a size match.

For example, it can replace a 613 prefix of a phone number with a 0.

A service identifier of *61359817777* would then become *0359817777*

Support for this feature is limited to Australian numbers only.

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
